Interview Committees

Each candidate will be interviewed by the following committees:

1. The College Board Committee selected by the Chair of the Mountain Empire Community College Board.
2. The Faculty/Staff/Student Committee which will consist of six faculty members (two from each division), four classified staff members, and two students. Members will be selected by the Faculty Senate, Association of Classified Employees, and Student Government Association.
3. The Administrators and President's Staff Committee which will consist of the administrators and classified staff who report directly to the President and three administrators who report directly to the Vice President of Academic and Student Services.
4. The Foundation Board Committee selected by the Chair of the Mountain Empire Community College Educational Foundation.
5. The Business, Education and Community Leaders Committee which will consist of public school and other external educators, elected officials, economic developers, and business professionals with proportionate representation from the service region of the college. These committee members will be invited to participate by the Chair of the College Board.

In addition to the interview committees, members of the college community will have an opportunity to meet the candidates at the Open Forum. Faculty and staff will serve as hosts for the candidates and their spouses/significant others.
