

1. When are the deadlines for admission:

- a. Spring admission deadline Oct 1
- b. Fall admission deadline June 1

2. Where are the physical forms located?

- a. Physical forms can be found in enrollment services. See Jacquie Hill.

3. When are physical forms due?

- a. Completed physicals are due on orientation day to the program

4. Will there be an orientation to the program?

- a. Yes. Orientation is held one week before PNE classes start. The orientation is mandatory and date/time/location of orientation will be listed on acceptance letters.

5. Where will I buy my uniforms?

- a. Uniform information will be given out during orientation.
- b. Uniforms can be purchased through In-Home Care in Norton, VA or through students choice of vendor but item numbers must match the information given during orientation for uniform.

6. What sciences are approved for admission?

- a. PNE 155, BIO 1, BIO 101 and/or 102 ; BIO 141 and/or 142 ; NAS 171; BIO 145; BIO 231 and/or 232 ; high school biology (ecology will not meet the requirement). But, this science requirement must be met within the last 5 years and with a C or better.

7. I would like to see an expense list.

9. How do I know I have been accepted into the PN program?

- a. You will receive a letter in the mail informing you of your admission status. Be patient, sometimes the letters are sent several weeks after testing.

10. When can I take the TEAS examination?

- a. You can take the TEAS examination at any time. You will register yourself for testing.
- b. TEAS scoring sheets must be turned in with PN application.

11. How do I register for the TEAS examination?

- a. Scheduling a TEAS examination: Go to www.mecc.edu/testing and click on the TEAS registration form link. Complete this form to register for a date and time to take the TEAS assessment. After you submit the form, you will receive an Outlook Calendar invitation within 48 hours.

12. How is the final decision made for admission?

- a. To be admitted to the program, you must have an overall scoring rubric average of 54 points. GPA-40% / non nursing courses completed-35% / TEAS V score-25%. Extra points available to you: CNA with 6 months work experience

13. How do I pay for the TEAS exam?

- a. You will pay for TEAS testing in the business office with credit card, debit card, or cash. No checks will be accepted.

- b. Soon, this process will change to a payment with credit card or debit card in the student services area as you begin your test. But for now, please register for TEAS and pay in the business office and take the receipt to student services.
- c. The test costs \$55.00; you must bring cash or credit card. After you pay for your test, take your receipt to student services. They will then help you login for testing.

14. Where can I find an application?

15. Who do I give my application to?

- a. You will print off the application and submit it to enrollment services.
- b. Please attach your TEAS scoring sheet to the application
- c. Official transcripts should also be requested to be sent to enrollment services at the time, or preferably before, application is submitted.
