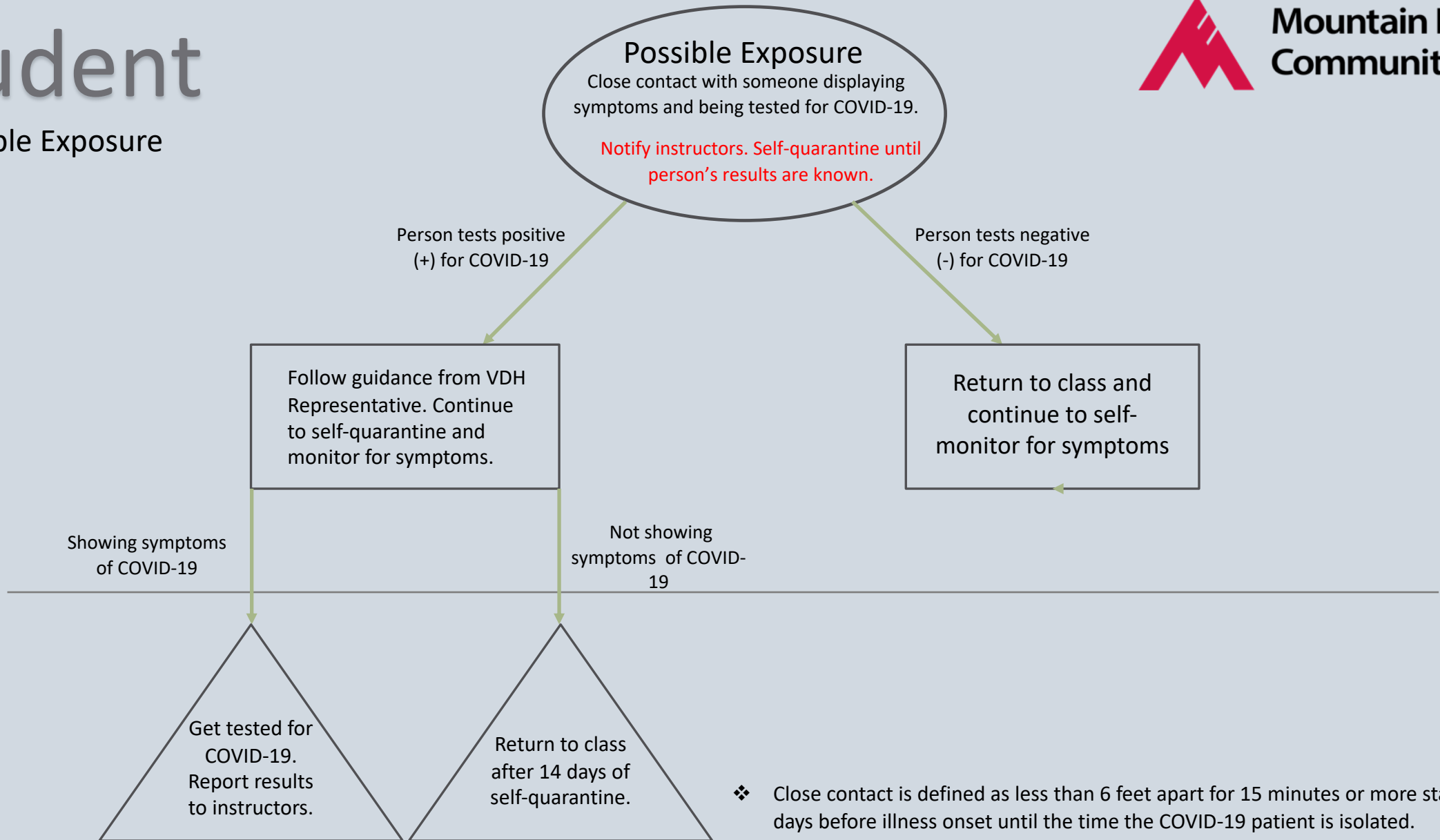
Test Confirmed Positive

- You are required to notify your instructor(s) if you test positive for COVID-19
- Close contact is defined as less than 6 feet apart for 15 minutes or more starting from 2 days before illness onset until the time the COVID-19 patient is isolated.
- If you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms please get tested and do not come to campus.
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea

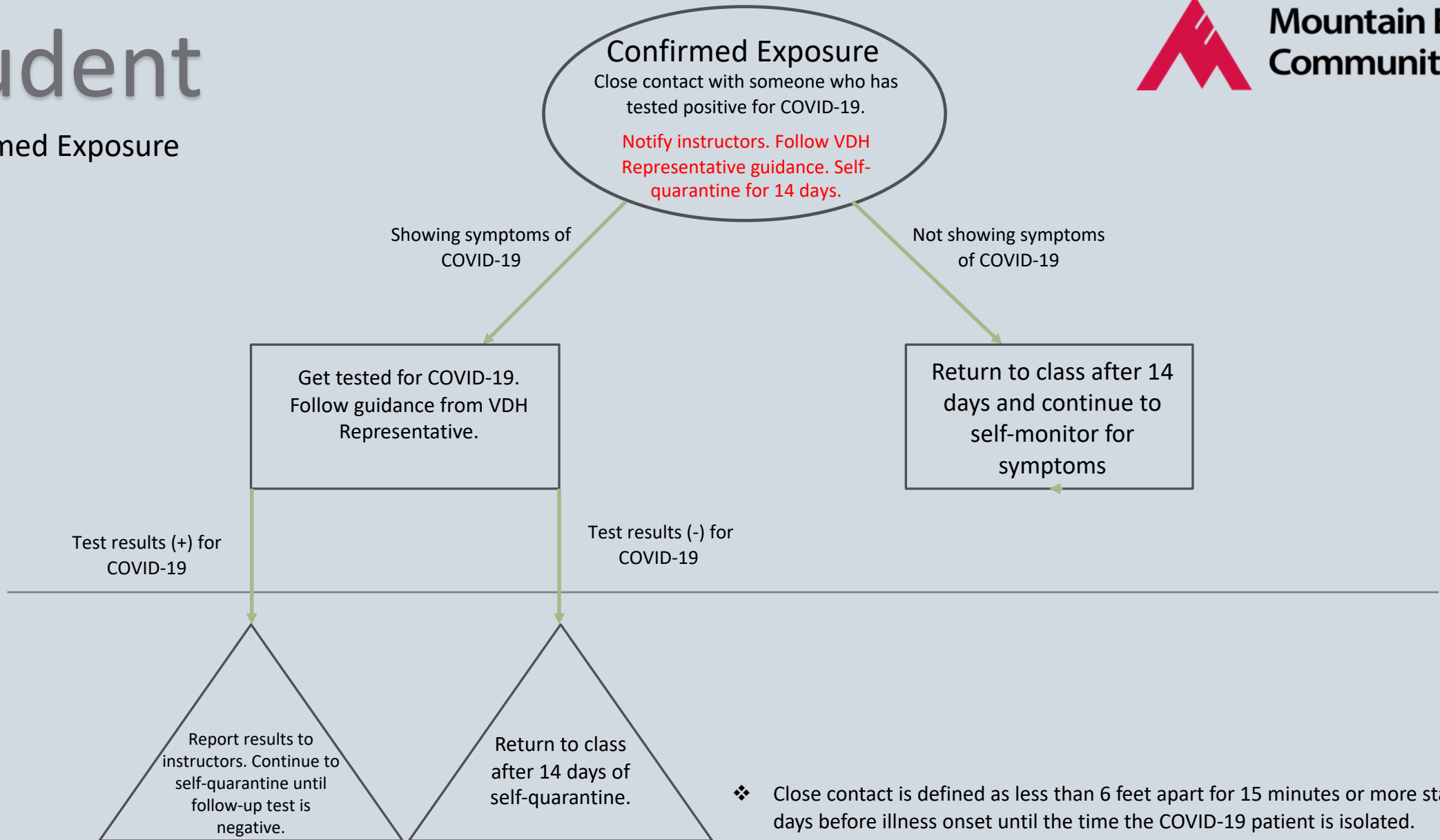
Possible Exposure

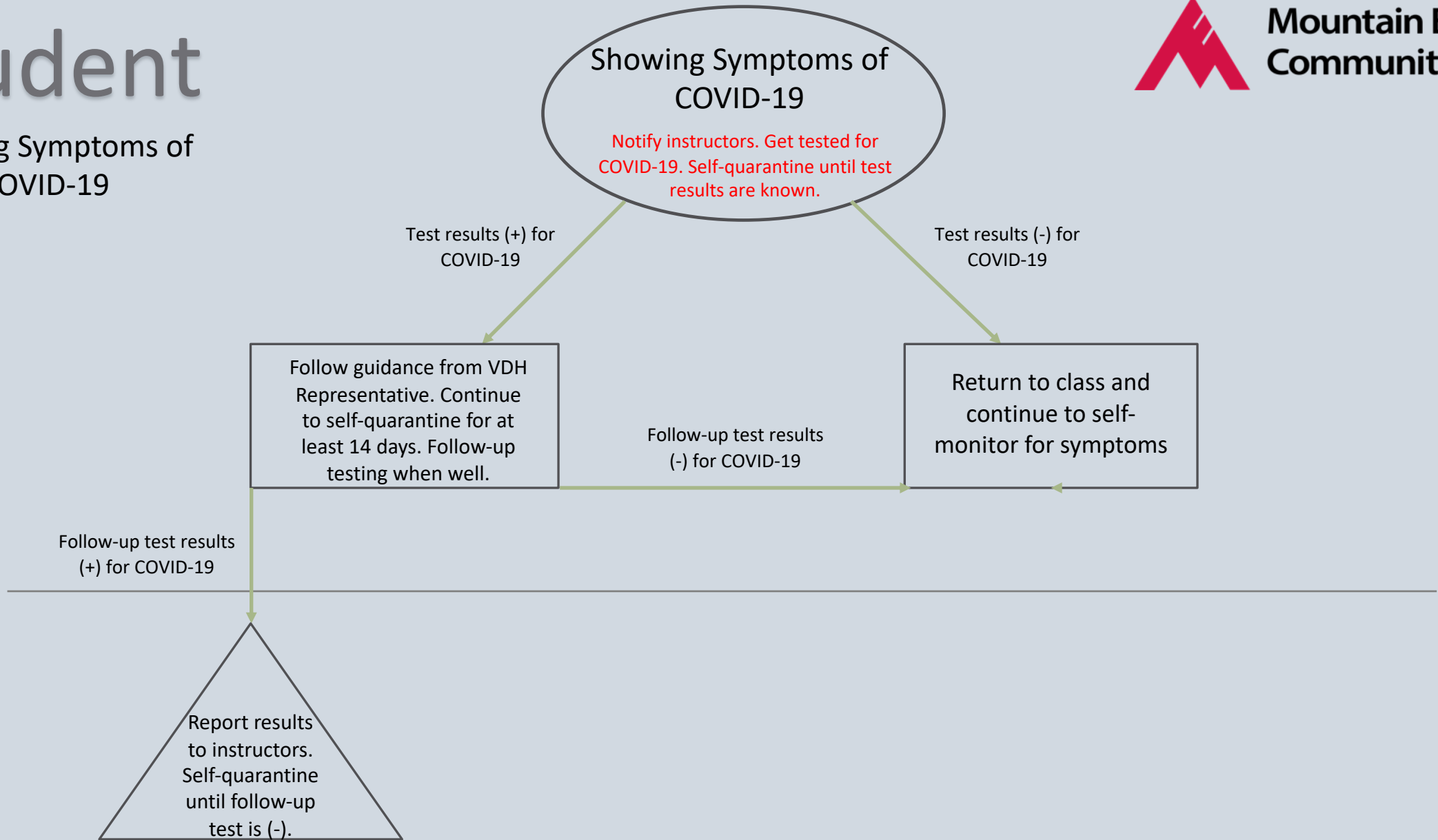
Confirmed Exposure
