

MECC: Building Careers and Better Lives for Lee Countians

Did You Know?

In 2017-18:

- 649 Lee County residents were enrolled at MECC
- 204 were dual enrollment students (enrolled in both high school and college)
- Of those Lee County residents who chose to attend college in Virginia, 79.6% attended MECC
- 10 Lee County High School graduates were named AIMS Scholar students (qualify for two years free tuition at MECC/UVA-Wise)
- 99 Lee County students graduated with degrees or certificates
- Top programs of study for Lee County students were: General Studies, Health Science, & Criminal Justice
- Lee County students received \$1.3 M in federal & state financial, scholarships & grants
- 106 Lee County program-placed had \$134,128 in unmet financial need (tuition expenses were not fully met by financial aid and scholarships)
